# Report of NYSASDRI – Education and Health care programme Supported by DCI

Reporting period - 1st January to 31st December 2013



NYSASDRI is managing 03 nos. schools at primary level in different location in Odisha. One is ODM Community School at Kashipur in Gondia Block of Dhenkanal district in which 85 nos. poor and tribal children are continuing their education from Nursery to standard 03 through CBSE pattern (English Medium). Other two schools are purely residential. 142 tribal's girls are studying in SEED Kanyashram, Malkanagiri. 172 tribal's girls are studying in NYSASDRI Educational Complex, Hukumtola, Rayagada district from class I to class V (through Odisha Education Board). Due to poverty and ignorance, the area is educationally very backward and girls education is almost nil. NYSASDRI taken various steps to promote tribal girls education in the area.

## Devastation (Cyclone) Phailin on 12th October 2013

We have faced devastation (Cyclone) Phailin on 12th October 2013 which is affected 18 district of Odisha. In the same time due to flood some coastal part of Odisha also severely affected. Fortunately our school structure was not much affected, few trees were uprooted and fall over the some part of infrastructure which causes some damages. Due to scarcity of food stuff like potatoes, onion and salt are not available in the market, we faced problem after cyclone.



During this reporting period construction of building for hostel is going on at ODM Community School and other work like renovation and colouring of school premises, purchases of instrument equipment for schools and repaired the furniture has been completed. One 05KV stabilizer installed in the premises of ODMCS for solves the low voltage of electricity problem. Initially we have planed hostel for 30 students residential purpose to be commenced from the academic year 2014-15.
