NYSASDRI Eye Hospital began its journey in 1988 with a mission to serve those unable to access or afford eye care. Over time, it became evident that sustaining such charitable activities required support through donations and grants. To achieve sustainability, the hospital relocated to a 2000 sq. ft. rented building in Dhenkanal Town on 20th October 2002 and was renamed Kalinga Eye Hospital & Research Centre. This shift aimed to continue serving the underprivileged while offering services to those who could afford them, ensuring the continuity of its mission.



Leprosy-hit cataract patients treated at Dhenkanal hospital

Representatives of Swiss-based BASAID appreciate effort

epresentatives Switzerland-based BASAID, Dr Erich, Rosa Schnurrenberger, Felix Heinz Mueller and Dr Helga Schmidt, visited the Kalinga Eye Hospital here on Monday. They exchanged views with the hospital inmates and appreciated the efforts of the hospital to provide treatment to leprosy-contaminated cataract patients.

BASAID has been providing three leprosy colonies in community empowerment activities for years. The Kalinga Eye Hospital is working on comprehensive eve-care services to the leprosy-cured patients with financial support of BASAID since 2005.

Hospital sources said they had to face a lot of difficulties initially as leprosy-affected people were considered as untouchable in the society. But Sasanka Mohanty of BASAID guided the hospital to overcome the situation and managed to conduct different programmes like out-

According to source, reach eye treatment camps in financial support to Orissa for Dhenkanal, seven in Jajpur and two in Angul districts.

From among these patients 53 have undergone eye surgery and 411 have received free pairs of refractive glasses. The hospital also distributed free medicines to other categories of natients after organising screening camps attended by experienced ophthalmologists. In 2007. NGO NYSADRI also upgraded the healthcare facilities at the Khankira PHC. to cater quality health services to the people of 22 villages near Dhenkanal town.






